bidden (bid) (v)	to command or order someone to do something.
condemn (v)	to be pronounced as guilty; sentence to punishment
curtsey (v)	a gesture of respect made by women by bending the knees with one foot forward and lowering the body (female bowing)
curry favor (v)	to seek to advance oneself through flattery or fawning; brown-nosing.
kirtle (n)	a woman's loose gown or loose man's shirt, worn in the Middle Ages
mock (v)	to treat with ridicule or contempt; to make fun of in a hurtful way
oblige (v)	to do a service or favor for someone
ordain (v)	to give orders with authority
pious (adj)	devoted religious person; showing high respect especially toward parents
procession (n)	the act of moving along or walking in a formal, orderly manner, as in a ceremony (wedding or funeral)
